This DEED made this 6th day of April in the year Eighteen hundred and ninety four by us James H. Culler and Lavinia M. Culler his wife, of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, Witnesseth that in consideration of Twenty two hundred and fifty dollars we the said James H. Culler and Lavinia M. Culler, his wife, do grant in fee simple unto George A. Stockman and Scharlotte A. Stockman his wife, all that part of a tract, or parcel of land situate lying and being in Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, Beginning for the same at the end of the 39th line of the whole tract called Muelheim and with said line North 37 27/60° West 106 2/10 perches to the end of the 1st line of the deed from G.W. Smith trustee to Thomas McPherson, and with the second line 30 3/4° East 44 perches, then South 81° East 4 2/10 perches to a large white oak tree, at the end of the 3rd line of the deed from G. W. Smith trustee, to Jacob M. Bushey and with said deed South 7 1/2° West 19 perches North 89 1/4° East 58 1/2° perches, then with the new lines now made this 19th day of February 1894 South 29 1/2° E. 31 2/10 perches, South 54 1/2° East 42 perches to one of the outlines of the whole farm of Peter Culler deceased as now surveyed South 24 1/2° West 25 2/10 perches, South 65 1/2° West 72 perches to the place of beginning containing 53 1/2 acres of land more or less.
