Wolfe, died on or about the date November 27th, 1933, a resident of the District of Columbia, leaving surviving him his widow, Lucy Mary Wolfe, now resident of the District of Columbia; and a daughter, Ruth Wolfe, who married to a certain Roy Ahrensfield, the said Ruth Wolfe Ahrensfield predeceased her father, on the date June 3, 1933, leaving surviving her her husband, Roy Ahrensfield, now resident of Berks County, Pennsylvania, a son Vincent Howard Ahrensfield, an infant under twenty-one years of age, residing in Berks County, Pennsylvania, a daughter, Dorothy Kershner, an infant under twenty-one years of age, now married to Charles Kershner, also residing in Berks County, Pennsylvania, a daughter, Lucille Kane, an infant under twenty-one years of age, now married to Albert Kane, and resident of Northampton County, Pennsylvania; and a daughter, Blanche F. Gannon married to George Gannon, and who are now residents of Montgomery County, in the State of Ohio; - a son, Lewis G. Wolfe, now married to Alva E. Wolfe, residents of the District of Columbia; - a daughter, Bessie A. Goodwin, now married to Edwin Goodwin, now residents of the District of Columbia; - a daughter, Mabel V. Wise, married to William Wise, and residents of the District of Columbia; - a son Harry W. Wolfe, now married to Esther Wolfe, and residents of the District of Columbia; -

SIXTH. That all of the right, title, interest and estate of the said Thomas H. Wolfe, who is now resident of Frederick County, in the state of Maryland, and unmarried, was sold by Roy H. Hiltner, Sheriff of Frederick County, to The FrederickTown Savings Institution, as evidenced by the Deed dated August 28th, in the year 1935, as found recorded in Liber No. 399, at folio 316, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland, a duly certified copy of which said Deed is filed herewith as a part hereof and marked "Exhibit E".

SEVENTH. That the said Caroline Wolfe Dutrow, who is married to Luther E. Dutrow, with her said husband is now resident of Stark County, in the State of Ohio.

EIGHTH. That the said Pauline A. Tabler, who is the daughter of Cora E. Suman, a deceased daughter of the said James K.P. Wolfe, is now married to John Tabler, and with her said husband resides in Summit County, in the State of Pennsylvania.

NINTH. That said real estate is described in said "Exhibit A", excepting therefrom the real estate described in "Exhibit B", is located in Frederick District, in Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, and improved with a frame dwelling house, is now in possession of a tenant.

TENTH. That said real estate cannot be divided without loss or injury to the parties interested.

WHEREFORE, your Orator prays:

1st. That your Honors will pass the Decree of your Honorable Court that said real estate described in said "Exhibit A", excepting therefrom the real estate described in "Exhibit B", be sold by a Trustee to be appointed by your Honorable Court, and that a division of the money arising from such sale may be made among the parties, according to their respective rights.
