"ORDER OF PUBLICATION"

No. 11986 Equity

In the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting in Equity

L. Cramer Powell and Irving S. Albaugh, partners trading as Powell and Albaugh; and N. Dorsey Norris, vs. Maria Smith, widow, Lottie Richardson, unmarried; and others.

The object of the Creditor's Bill filed in the above cause, is to procure a decree for the sale of certain real estate situated in Frederick County, Maryland, about two miles from Unionville, of which one Charles G. Richardson who died in said County in June 1929, seized and possessed;

That the said Charles G. Richardson whose wife died about eight years ago, left surviving him Maria Smith, widow, and Lottie Richardson, unmarried; both sisters, and the following nieces and nephews, as his heirs at law; Elizabeth Valentine, widow, Lottie Gardner married to William Gardner; Annie Brown married to Philemon Brown; John Duppins whose wife's name is Edna Duppins; Alice Duppins, unmarried; William Duppins whose wife's name is Mazie Duppins; James Duppins, whose wife's name is Gertie Duppins; and Clarence Duppins whose wife's name is Maggie Duppins, all children of one Jane Duppins, a deceased sister of said Charles G. Richardson; Olevia Dixon who is married to Bates Dixon and Perry Richardson whose wife's name is Annie May Richardson, and Ella Richardson, unmarried, all children of one Richard Richardson, a deceased brother; William Richardson, unmarried and Norman Richardson unmarried, two sons of one William Richardson, a deceased brother; and Margaret Waters who is married to Waters child of one John Richardson, a deceased brother;

That the said above named defendante, Maria Smith, Lottie Richardson, Elizabeth Valentine, Lottie Gardner, William Gardner, John Duppins, Edna Duppins, Alice Duppins, William Duppins, and Mazie Duppins, are residents of said Frederick County: that Annie Brown and Philemon Brown are residents of Baltimore County, Maryland, that Clarence Duppins, Maggie Duppins, and Ella Richardson are residents of Baltimore City, Maryland; that James Duppins, Gertie Duppins Olevia Dixon, Bates Dixon, Perry Richardson, Annie May Richardson, William Richardson, Norman Richardson, Margaret Waters and Waters her husband, are non residents of the State of Maryland, being residents of the City of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania; and that all of said defendants are adults, over twenty-one years of age;

That the real estate of which the said Charles G. Richardson died seized and possessed, consists of two lots or peices of ground with improvements and buildings thereon, and being the same real estate which the said Charles G. Richardson obtained by deed from John A. Richardson and others dated November 18, 1896 and recorded in Liber J. L. J. NO. 14, folios 653 etc., one of said Frederick County Land Records, a certified copy of which is filed with the Bill:

That the estate of the said Charles G. Richardson is indebted unto the Plaintiffs, Powell and Albaugh, for funeral expenses, in amount \$90.00, and further indebted unto N. Dorsey Norris under a sealed note of said Charles G. Richardson in amount \$34.00 with interest from
