

2nd. And for such other, further and general relief as your Orators may be entitled in the premises, and as unto your Honors will appear to be just and equitable.

3rd. May it please your Honors to grant unto your Orators the writ of subpoena directed to Philip A. Probee resident of Frederick City, Frederick County, Maryland, commanding him to be and appear either in person or by Solicitor in your Honorable Court on or before a certain day to be named therein, to answer the Bill of Complaint and to show cause, if any he has why a decree ought not be passed as prayed.

And also that they may be granted the Order of Publication directed to the defendant Annie S. Probee, residing in East Boston, State of Massachusetts and is non resident of the State of Maryland, giving her notice of the object and substance of this Bill and warning her to be and appear in this Court either in person or by Solicitor on or before a certain day to be named therein, to show cause if any she has, why a Decree should not be passed as prayed.

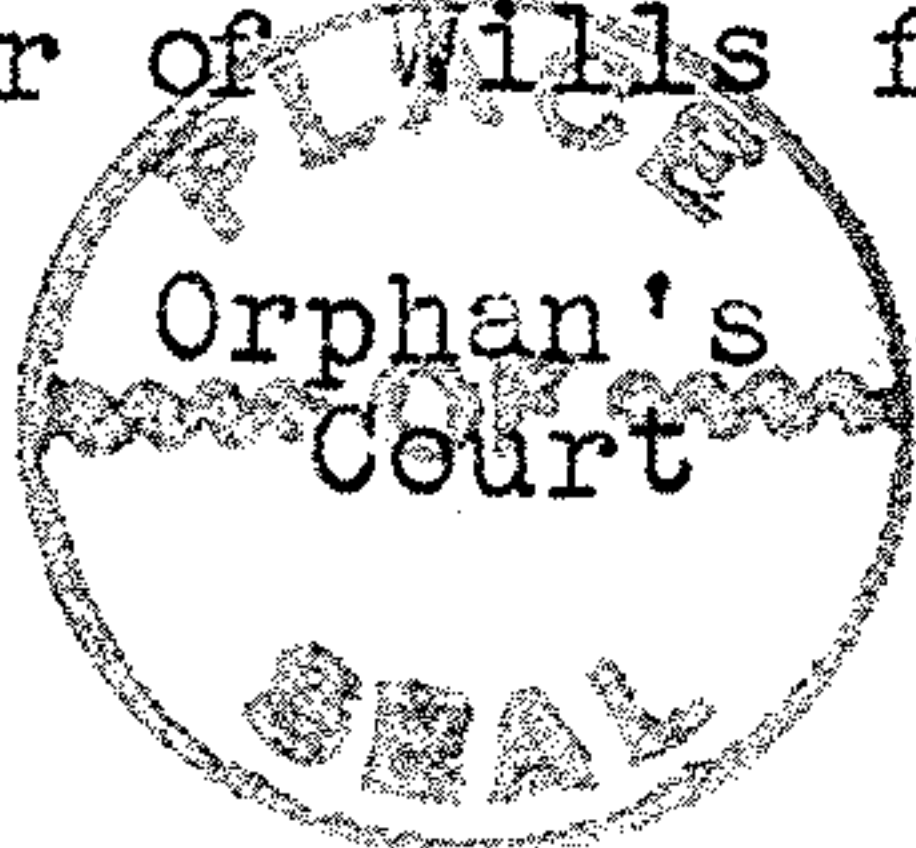
