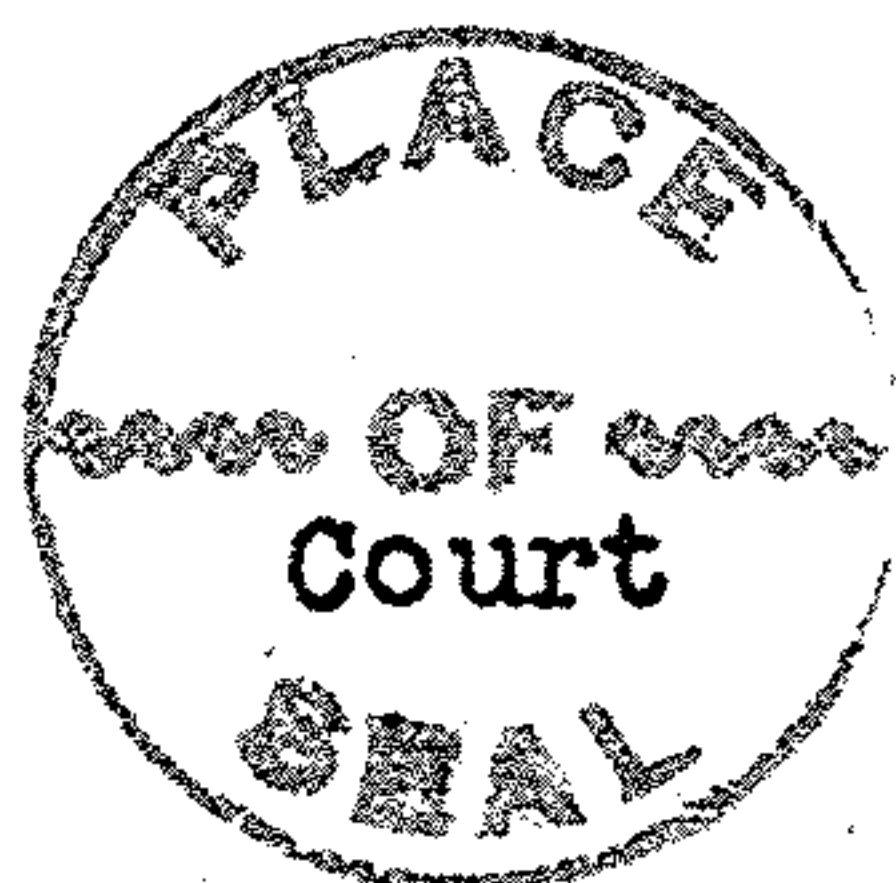

This Deed made this 10 day of February in the year Eighteen hundred and ninety, by us, Elizabeth Kreh, John F. Kreh, and Julia Kreh, his wife, Charles Kreh and Mary M. Kreh, his wife, Mary E. Yost and George Yost, her husband and Lewis T. Kreh parties of the first part, Witnesseth Whereas Peter Kreh late of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, hath departed this life testate leaving a last will duly admitted to probate in the Orphans Court of Frederick County aforesaid, bearing date on the 24th day of May, 1870 and recorded in Liber H. S. No. 1, folio 52 one of the Record Books of Wills in the office of the Register of Wills for Frederick County, and whereas by the provisions of said will, the said testator devised all his real estate contingently to his widow, the said Elizabeth Kreh and to his children the said John F. Kreh, Charles Kreh, Mary E. Yost Lewis T. Kreh and William H. Kreh, and also appointed the said Elizabeth Kreh sole Executrix of said last will and, whereas the parties of the first part hereto have sold to the said William H. Kreh for the sum of Fifty dollars all their undivided right and title, present contingent or in remainder, in and to the hereinafter described lot of ground, being part of the land devised as aforesaid, and the said William H.
