My name is John D. Eichelberger, I am thirty-eight years of age and I am a son of George M. Eichelberger, and Emma E. Eichelberger, his wife.

My father was the owner at the time of his death, of a parcel of land which he got from Joseph H. W. Fick and Margaret Fick , his wife, which said deed is described in Exhibit No. 3 filed in this case. During my father's lifetime he sold off a piece of said property to Sarah E. Eyer which said deed is described in Exhibit No. 4 to the Bill of Complaint in this cause. My father left the following as his heirs at law and next of kin: My Mother Emma E. Eichelberger, who is now his widow, George M. Eichelberger and whose wife's name is Ella Eichelberger, Raymond E. Eichelberger, widower, myself, John D. Eichelberger, whose wife's name is Edna V. Eichelberger, Elizabeth Isanogle, whose husband's name is Harry N. Isanogle, Nellie A. Heim, whose husband's name is Charles E. Heim, Bessie Martin whose husbands name is Calvin Martin, Rubie N. Fisher, whose husband's name is Charles L. Fisher and Martin S. Eichelberger whose wife's name is Lulu Eichelberger. These are all the children of my father and not any of my brothers and sisters are dead leaving children.

My name is Lester S. Birely, and I am fifth years of age and reside at Thurmont, Frederick County, Maryland.

Eichelberger at the time of his death was the owner of the property described in Exhibit No. 3 in this cause, less the portion sold therefrom, known as Exhibits No. 4. I am familiar with this property and have known it for thirty years, and I am also familiar with values in the vicinity of Thurmont, and in my judgment this property is worth at the present time about \$2500.00. Mr. Eichelberger died intestate and did not leave sufficient personal estate to pay his indebtedness. At the time of Mr. Eichelberger's death, he left his widow, Emma E. Eichelberger, and the following children, all of whom are adults: George M. Eichelberger, whose wife's name is Ella Eichelberger, Raymond E. Eichelberger, whose wife's dead. John D. Eichelberger, whose wife's name is Edna Eichelberger, Elizabeth E. Isanogle, Harry N. Isanogle, her husband, Nellie A. Heim, whose husband's name is Charles E. Heim, Bessie M.
