TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition of Katherine V. Lambert, the Plaintiff in the above entitled cause, respectfully shows:

FIRST: That on June, 26, 1935, your Petitioner filed her Bill of Complaint herein for the sale of certain real estate owned in common by her and her former husband, Arthur D. Lambert.

SECOND: That there was inadvertently omitted from said Bill of Complaint, all reference to the growing crops, farming implements, livestock and other personal property on said farm, as well as household furniture and effects located in the said home on said farm, all of which are also owned jointly by your Petitioner and her former husband,

THIRD: That your Petitioner desires to amend said Bill of Complaint by adding thereto a new paragraph numbered four, and to read as follows:

Four: That the Plaintiff and the Defendant also owned as tenants in common the wheat crop and certain other growing crops, farming implements, livestock and other personal property on said farm, as well as household furniture and effects located in the home on said farm.

FOURTH: That your Petitioner also desires to amend said Bill of Complaint by adding another prayer for relief to be designated as 1-A, and to read as follows:

That a sale of all the personal property aforesaid also be decreed by this Court to be made by the trustees to be appointed as aforesaid, and the proceeds therefrom to be divided between the parties hereto according to their respective interests.
