

time of the making thereof, and that what has since or shall hereafter come to his hands and possession he will return an additional Inventory thereof, that he knows of no concealment of any part or parcel of the deceased's estate, by any person or persons whatsoever, and that if he should hereafter discover any concealment, or suspect any to be, he will acquaint the Orphans' Court, or the Register of Wills, with such concealment, or cause of suspicion, so that it may be inquired into according to law.

First and principally I commit my soul into the hands of Almighty God, and my body to the earth to be decently buried and after my debts and funeral charges are paid, I devise and bequeath as follows.

I give and devise unto my grandson Milton Bowers all my real estate upon which I now reside lying in woodsboro District.

I desire and direct that all the costs and Court charges and commission shall be paid by my grandson Milton Bowers out of his legacy.

and lastly, I do hereby constitute and appoint my three grandchildren Milton Bowers S. Virginia Bowers and Emily J. Bowers my executors of this my last will and testament.
