The aforesaid devise to my said wife is in lieu of her dower in my said real estate.

I do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my said son Frank E. Williar, executor of this my last will and testament, hereby revoking and making null and void all other wills by me heretofore made, ratifying and confirming this and none other as and for my last will and testament,
