The Petition and Report of Sale of Amos A. Holter, Assignee of the Commercial Bank of Maryland, a body corporate, formerly the Commercial State Bank of Frederick, Maryland; Assignee of Clayton H. Summers, Mortgagee of Lawson H. Summers and Eva M. Summers, his wife, respectfully shows unto your Honors:

That a certain Lawson H. Summers and Eva M. Summers, his wife, residents of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, being indebted unto Clayton H. Summers of Frederick County, Maryland, in the full and just sum of Eight Thousand (\$8000.00) Dollars, for money borrowed by the said Lawson H. Summers and Eva M. Summers, his wife, from the said Clayton H. Summers upon their joint and several promissory note dated April 1, 1921, payable six months after date, with interest from date, and for the purpose of better securing the payment of said promissory note, executed and delivered unto the said Clayton H. Summers their Deed of Mortgage dated April 1, 1921, granting and conveying unto the said Clayton H. Summers as Mortgagee, all those lots of ground situate, lying and being near Frederick City, in Frederick County, State of Maryland, being Lots Numbered 113, 114 and 115 on a plat entitled "Villa Estates", prepared by Emory C. Crum, Civil Engineer, dated May 31st, 1915, and recorded in Plat Book S.T.H. Folio 78, as will more fully appear by a copy of which said Plat is filed herewith as "Exhibit A", and which is prayed may be taken and considered a part hereof; being the same property which was conveyed unto the said Lawson H.
