Folio 134, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, being a subdivision of said lots Nos. 113, 114, 115 as shown upon the plat hereinbefore mentioned recorded in Plat Book S.T.H. folio 78, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland, to which said plat reference is hereby made for a more particular description of the lots hereinbefore mentioned.

Several of the aforementioned lots front on Wilson Avenue and West 7th Streets Extended, respectively, and the remainder of said lots are immediately adjacent thereto fronting on Grant Place. With the exception of the lots fronting on West 7th street, extended, all of the lots have a uniform frontage of 50 feet and lots fronting on Wilson Place and on the West side of Grant Place have a uniform depth of 190 feet; lots
