Witnesseth, that in consideration of two hundred and fifty dollars, the said Jacob Dorcas and Ellen his wife doth grant unto George D. Shank, of the County and State aforesaid One half interest in fee simple in a lot of Ground situated on the road leading from Woodsboro to Creagerstown beginning at a stone planted at the said road and running North East to a stone planted at the rail road, thence with the line of the rail road to the Creagerstown road, thence with the said road north west to the beginning it being the same lot upon which the ware house stands.
