To the Honorable, the Judges of said Court:

The petition of George Albert Wilson and John Evan Wilson, the plaintiffs in the above cause, by Albert S. Brown, their Solicitor respectfully show unto your Honors:

FIRST: That on May 13, 1935 a petition was duly filed asking for the appointment of a Guardian ad litem for the infant defendants in this cause, through inadvertence there was omitted Rachel Wilson Harrison and Hallie Wilson both of whom are infants under the age of 21 years, neither of whom have a legal Guardian duly appointed and they and each of them are disqualified to answer the allegations of the Bill of Complaint by reason of their infancy, altho both were duly summoned.
