

FIRST: That she admits the allegations contained in the first and second paragraphs of the said Bill of Complaint.

SECOND: That she also admits the allegations contained in the third and fourth paragraphs of said Bill of Complaint.

THIRD: That while she does not object to the sale of the real estate, she only assents thereto without prejudice to her right to assert and enforce her claim against the proceeds of the sale of said real estate for services rendered to the said Annie P Stream, as will be set forth in the Declaration in the action at law about to be brought in the Circuit Court for Frederick County by the said M. Alberta Stevens against the estate of the said Annie P. Stream; and the said M. Alberta Stevens hereby reserves all of her rights against the said estate and against the proceeds of the sale of the real estate described in these proceedings in the enforcement of her claim aforesaid.

WHEREFORE, having fully answered, this Respondent prays to be hence dismissed with her reasonable costs.
