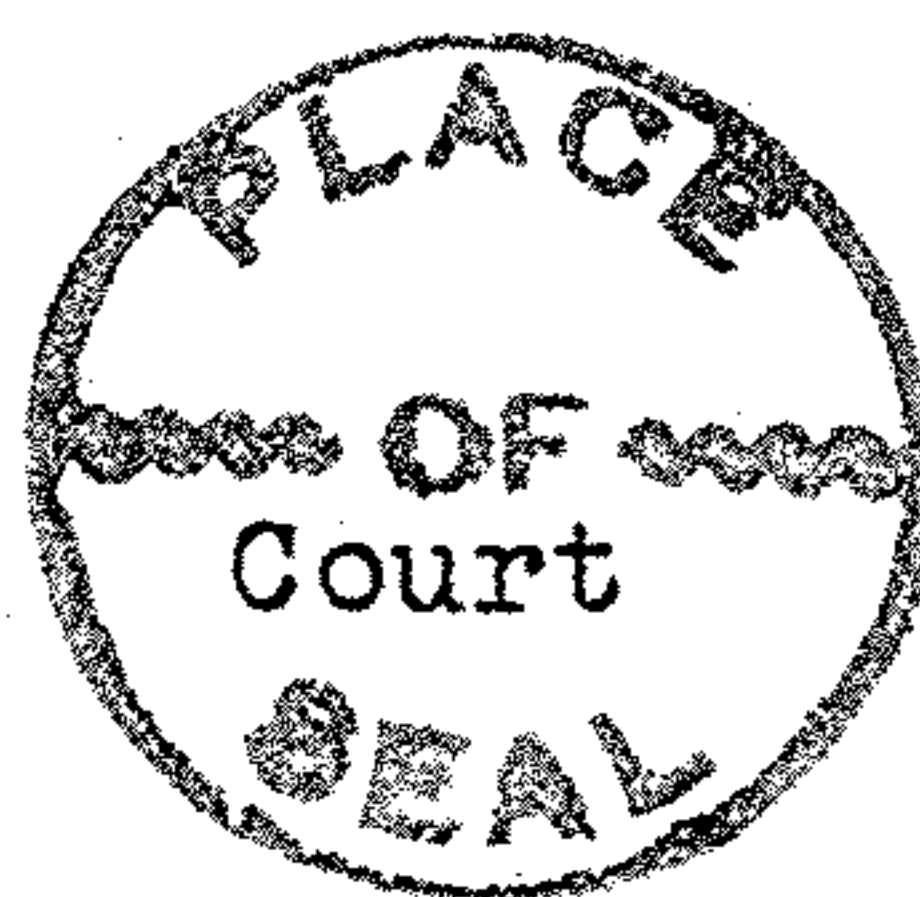

The Bill of Complaint of Frank H. Grim and Mary V. Grim, his wife, respectfully represents unto your Honorable Court:

FIRST: That a certain Susan V. McNeally died on or about the 16th day of June, 1934, leaving a last Will and Testament wherein she disposed of her personal property but made no disposition of the real estate hereinafter described.
