

that it would be to the benefit and advantage of all the parties interested therein that said real estate be sold, under the direction of the Court, and the net proceeds be divided according to the rights and interests of the parties entitled.

The Bill prays that a decree may be passed for a sale of said real estate and the net proceeds be divided among the parties entitled according to their respective interests, and for general relief.

ORDERED this 9th day of June, 1936, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, sitting as a Court of Equity, and by the authority thereof, that the Complainants cause a copy of this Order, together with a statement of the object and substance of the Bill of Complaint filed in this cause, to be published in some newspaper printed and published in Frederick County, Maryland, once a week for four successive weeks prior to the 9th day of July, 1936, giving notice to the Defendants in said Bill of Complaint of the object and substance thereof, and warning them to appear in this Court, in person or by Solicitor, on or before the 25th day of July, 1936, to show cause, if any they have, why a decree ought not to be passed as prayed.
