

loans only to persons in the employ of The Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Company, it is therefore, agreed by and between the parties hereto, and as a condition of the loan hereby secured, that in event the property herein described be conveyed by the said parties of the first part, without the consent of the party of the second part, in writing, to any persons not in the employ of The Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Company, then the said party of the second part shall have the option, upon not less than sixty days' notice in writing, to the owner or to the occupant of the premises herein described left on the premises, to declare the entire debt then unpaid to be due and demandable, any other provision herein to the contrary notwithstanding, and upon the failure of said first parties to immediately pay said debt, this Mortgage shall thereupon become absolute and the said party of the second part shall thereupon have the right forthwith to foreclose this mortgage as upon default in the payment of the installments above mentioned.

This right may be exercised at any time after any such conveyance be made, and no acceptance of payments from or on behalf of the grantee shall operate as a waiver thereof,

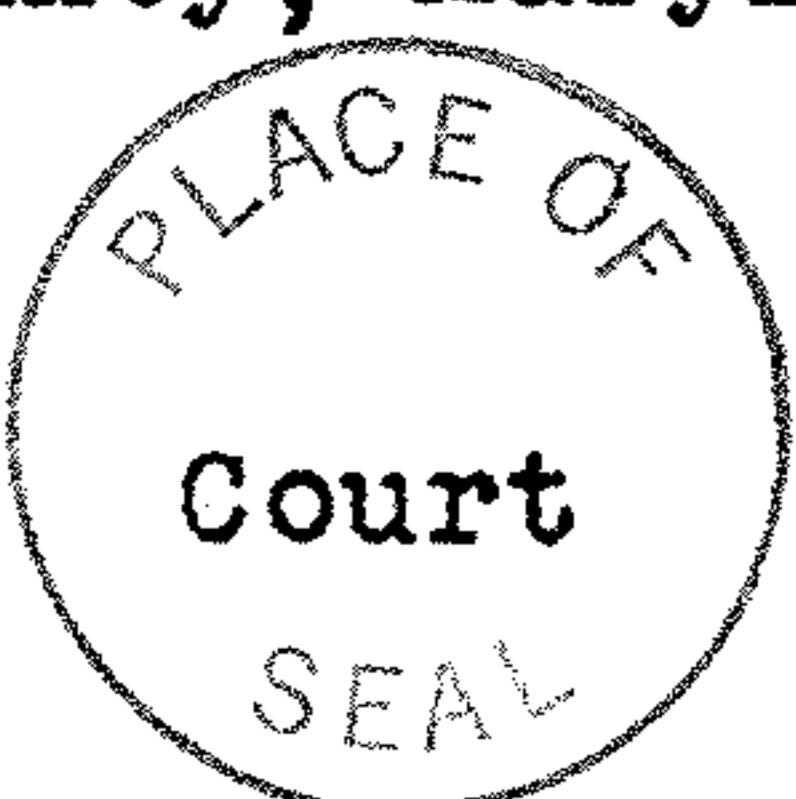
