The petition of the Peoples Liquidating Corporation, a body corporate of the State of Maryland, Assignee, etc., respectfully represents unto your Honorable Court:

1. That your petitioner is the holder by assignment of two judgment (a) a judgment dated November 20, 1929 for \$300.00 against Florence E. Stitely and Joseph E. Stitely, her husband, Percy C. Wolfe and Agnes M. Wolfe, his wife, with interest from date and costs of suit, which said judgment on September 6, 1934 was entered to the use of your petition by the Central Trust Company, Receiver, plaintiff, and judgment recorded in Judgment Docket #23, Folio 145 in the Circuit Court for Carroll County, Maryland, as shown by a certified copy of the judgment filed herewith and marked Plaintiff's Exhibit #1 and prayed to be taken as a part of this Bill of Complaint, on which judgment the balance is \$278.12, with interest from November 1, 1929.
