

that the adopted son, George William Stitely, is unmarried and has no lawful issue, and your oratrix now charges, by way of amendment (or supplement) to her aforesaid Bill of Complaint, that the said infant children are necessary parties to said suit, in accordance with Section 243 of Article 16 of the Code of Public General Laws of the State of Maryland.

TO THE END, THEREFORE,

(1) That the said Emory Wolfe, Earle Wolfe and Ruth Wolfe, infants, may answer this amendment and that the other said parties defendants to the original bill of complaint may answer this amendment and that both the said infants and the said original parties defendants respectively may answer, as well as the matter charged in the original bill of complaint, as in this amended bill.

(2) That your Oratrix may have such other and further relief against the said original parties defendants as well as the said infants named in this petition, as is prayed by her original bill against the said Joseph E. Stitely et al.

May it please your Honors to grant unto your Oratrix the writ of subpoena directed to the said Joseph E. Stitely, adult, Agnes M. Wolfe and Percy C. Wolfe, her husband, both adults, George William Stitely, infant, residing with your complainant and her husband, all of McKinstry's Mills, Carroll County, Maryland, C. Robert Brillhart, adult, former Tax Collector of Carroll County, Maryland, resident at Manchester, Joseph H. Weller, adult, Linwood, Carroll County, Maryland and the said Emory Wolfe, infant, Earle Wolfe, infant and Ruth Wolfe, infant, residing with their parents, Agnes M. Wolfe and Percy C. Wolfe, at McKinstry's Mills, Carroll County, Maryland, commanding them and each of them to be and appear in this Court, at some certain day to be named therein and to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein.
