

Upon the foregoing petition and after an examination of the proceedings and order of Court heretofore passed, it appearing that the guardian ad litem of all the defendants has submitted the interests and rights of said infants to the Court here for its action and protection and that the defendant purchaser, Joseph H. Weller, has filed his answer traversing in part the allegations of the petition of Florence E. Stitely and Joseph E. Stitely her husband, filed in this cause on June 8th, 1936, and it further appearing that the two adult defendants, Percy C. Wolfe and Agnes N. Wolfe, his wife, although duly served with notice have failed to answer said petition filed as aforesaid, it is thereupon ordered and decreed that leave be and is hereby this 6th day of July, 1936, by the Circuit Court for Carroll County in Equity, adjudged and ordered that as against the said Percy C. Wolfe and Agnes N. Wolfe, his wife, the decree pro confesso be entered so as to take as against them the allegations of said petition as true; and that as to the said four infant defendants, and the purchaser, Joseph H. Weller, the allegations are at issue and the burden upon the petitioners, Florence E. Stitely and Joseph E. Stitely, her husband, to establish the allegations of fact at issue, and that leave be and is hereby granted to the said petitioners, Florence E. Stitely and Joseph E. Stitely, her husband, to take testimony to support their allegations of fact before one of the standing examiners in equity of this Court, after giving the usual notice, and, similarly, the infants by their guardian ad litem and the purchaser, Joseph H. Weller, are granted leave to take such testimony which shall all be forthwith returned to the Court here;

And it is hereby further adjudged and decreed that the matter of said petition be set down for a hearing before the Court here on Monday, July 13th, 1936, at one o'clock P. M.
