

D. H. H. No. 1, Folio 271, one of the Land Records of Frederick County.

Together with all the buildings and improvements thereon and all the rights, privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging or appertaining, especially is the right hereby granted unto the said Edward Fry, his heirs and assigns, for the use of the well now located near the divisional line of the property hereby conveyed and the remaining portion of the lot of the said Alice C. Fry died seised and possessed, and to have amended the decree of your Honorable Court heretofore passed in this cause, nunc pro tunc, and to have ratified and confirmed the said sale of the said real estate heretofore made and reported to your Honorable Court by the Trustee in this cause.

WHEREFORE, your petitioners pray your Honorable Court for leave to amend the said Bill of Complaint by inserting the said correct description in lieu of the erroneous description as contained in the Bill of Complaint.

And your petitioners further pray your Honorable Court to amend the decree heretofore filed in this cause nunc pro tunc and to ratify and confirm the said sales of the lot or parcel of land heretofore made and reported to your Honorable Court by the Trustee in this cause.
