TO THE HONORABLE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:-

The Complainant, Casper E. Cline, who sues as well for himself as for all other creditors of Charles A. Poole, late of Frederick County, Maryland, deceased, who will come in and contribute to the expenses of this suit, complaining, says:-

1. That the said Charles A. Poole died intestate on or about October 28, 1933, and your Orator, Casper E. Cline, furnished certain funeral services and things for and about the burial of the said Charles A. Poole of the value of \$400.00, of which said sum Victoria L. Poole, widow of the said Charles A. Poole, during her lifetime paid unto your Orator the sum of \$200.00, and the remainder of \$200.00 still remains due and is a proper charge against the estate of the said Charles A. Poole, deceased, itemized copy of said statement of account being filed herewith as part hereof, marked "Exhibit A".

2. That the said Charles A. Poole, at the time of his decease, was seized and possessed of the lot of land and premises known as numbers 113 and 115 West South Street, in Frederick City, Frederick County, State of Maryland, fronting about 31 feet on the north side of said West South Street, and running back for depth about 218 feet, improved by a 2-story double dwelling house valued at about \$3,000.00, the deed for which being from Charles E. Mealey
