This deed made this 22nd day of November in the year eighteen hundred and ninety nine by Caroline S. Houghton and Charles E. Houghton, her husband residents of Baltimore City, Maryland; Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and fifty dollars current money this date paid unto us by Charles A. Poole resident of Frederick City, in Frederick County, Maryland, at and before the execution and delivery of this deed the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged we the said Caroline S. Houghton and Charles E. Houghton her husband, do hereby grant and convey unto the said Charles A. Poole, all the following lots or parts of lots or parcels of ground situated, lying and being in Frederick City, in Frederick County and State of Maryland, and described as follows, namely, being all that land, lying on the south side of west south street in said city, beginning for the part of land hereby intended to be conveyed on the South side of West South street, aforesaid and at the North East corner of the whole lot aforesaid of which Louis McMurray died, seized and possessed it being also the North west corner of the property now owned and occupied by a certain Christopher Schade, and running thence first, South eleven degrees west three hundred and ninety four and one half feet, thence second, South eighty degrees east sixty one and one-half feet, thence third, South twenty nine and one half degrees west four hundred and seventy-seven feet to the north side of Madison street and with it thence fourth North sixty one degrees west one hundred feet to the east side of McMurray street and with it thence fifth North twenty seven
