TO THE HONORABLE THE JUDGES OF THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR FREDERICK COUNTY, SITTING AS A COURT OF EQUITY:

The Bill of Complaint of Claude W. Wilhide and Elizabeth E. Wilhide, his wife; Walter N. Wilhide and Margaret W. Wilhide, his wife; Glenn C. Wilhide and Margaret H. Wilhide, his wife; and Margaret Wilhide, unmarried, respectfully shows unto your Honors: /

First: That Amanda M. Wilhide, late of Frederick County, Maryland, deceased, died intestate on or about the second day of April, in the year 1936, seised and possessed of a certain lot or parcel of land improved with a dwelling house, situated in the village of Walkersville, Frederick County, State of Maryland, and fronting on Fulton Avenue, in the said village, the major portion of which was conveyed unto the said Amanda M. Wilhide by Zachary T. Cromwell, by deed bearing date on the fifth day of June, 1897, and recorded in Liber J. L. J. No. 16, Folio 303, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, and a small portion in the rear thereof was purchased by the said Amanda M. Wilhide from Zachary T. Cromwell in or about the year 1911, and the said Amanda M. Wilhide entered into the occupancy of the said small parcel and has claimed title thereto and exercised exclusive dominion over the said small parcel since in or about the said year 1911, to the time of her death on or about April 2nd, 1936, as aforesaid, but the said Amanda M. Wilhide never received a deed therefor in her lifetime, but the same was conveyed to the heirs of the said Amanda M. Wilhide, the parties to this cause, by the Trustees of the United Brethren Church in Walkersville, by deed bearing date on the eleventh day of May, 1936, and recorded May 26th, 1936, in Liber No. 402, Folio 163, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, certified copies of the said two deeds are herewith filed, marked "Exhibit No. 1" and Exhibit No. 2", and prayed to be taken as a part hereof.

Second: That the said Amanda M. Wilhide left her surviving as her only heirs at law,
