TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Bill of Complaint of Marie A. Townsend and Hugh S. Townsend, her husband, respectfully represents unto your Honorable Court:

FIRST: That Samuel C. Brown, late of Frederick County, Maryland, departed this life intestate in the year, 1935, possessed of a certain parcel of real estate situate, lying and being on the road leading from Thurmont to Sabillasville, and being the same parcel of land that was conveyed to Samuel C. Brown by deed from Blanche Weddle Daly, et al. dated May 3, 1929, and recorded in Liber No. 370, folio 544, one of the Land Records for Frederick County, a certified copy of which is filed herewith marked Exhibit No. 1 and it is prayed may be taken and considered a part of this Bill of Complaint.

SECOND: That the defendant, the First National Bank of Blue Ridge Summit, Pennsylvania, a body corporate, is the holder of a judgment against the said Samuel C.
