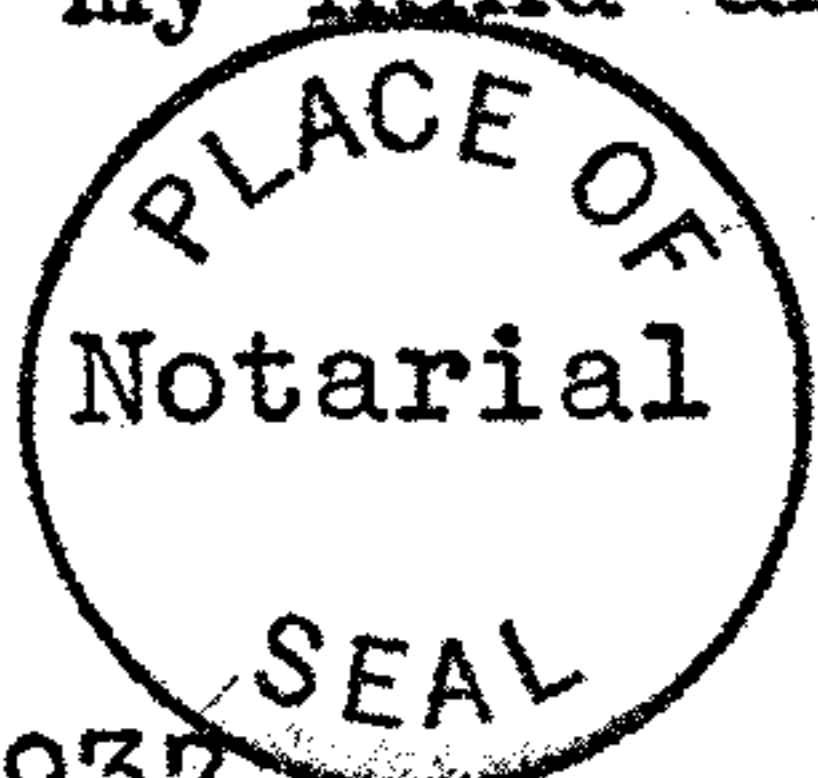

MARYLAND  
AMORTIZATION MORTGAGE

THIS MORTGAGE, made the TWENTY SECOND day of JANUARY in the year nineteen hundred and  
THIRTY FOUR, by and between WILLIAM K. BIRELY, unmarried of the County of FREDERICK, State  
of Maryland, hereinafter called "Mortgagor" (and the pronouns "he", "his", "him" hereinafter

and the Land Bank Commissioner, whose address is the City of Baltimore, State of Maryland,  
acting pursuant to Part 3 of the Act of Congress of the United States of America, known as  
the "Emergency Farm Mortgage Act of 1933", hereinafter called "Commissioner", party of the  
second part,

WITNESSETH: THAT WHEREAS, said Mortgagor is justly indebted to said Commissioner in
