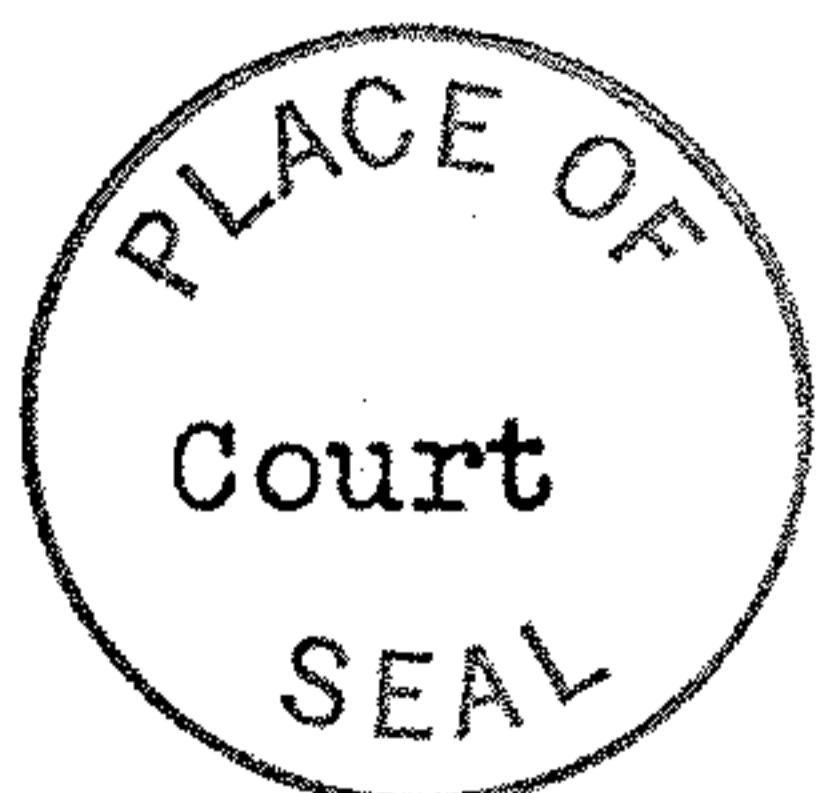
DECREE
