TO THE HONORABLE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Complainant, Samuel R. Ridgeway, who sues as well for himself as for all other creditors of Frank Bruchey, late of Frederick County, Maryland, deceased, who will come in and contribute to the expenses of this suit, complaining, says:

1. That the said Frank Bruchey, late of Frederick County, Maryland, was, in his life time and at the time of his death, indebted to one Samuel R. Ridgeway, Lovettsville, Virginia, in the sum of Four Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$490.00) and interest, which claim has been duly filed in the Orphans' Court for Frederick County, Maryland.
