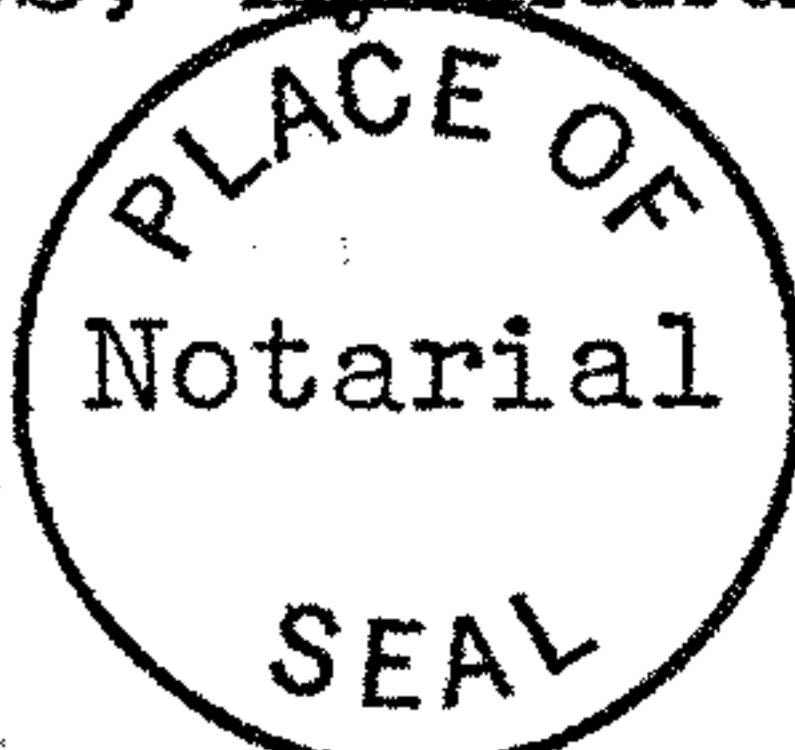

MARYLAND
AMORTIZATION MORTGAGE

THIS MORTGAGE, made the ELEVENTH day of JANUARY in the year nineteen hundred and THIRTY FOUR, by and between ISAAC C. GILLESPIE and MARY V. GILLESPIE, his wife, of the County of FREDERICK, State of Maryland, hereinafter called "Mortgagor" (and the pronouns "he", "his", "him" hereinafter used in reference to said term "Mortgagor", shall be considered as referring to both sexes and to all parties, whether one or more, embraced in said term), party of the first part, and the Land Bank Commissioner, whose address is the City of Baltimore, State of Maryland, acting pursuant to Part 3 of the Act of Congress of the United States of America, known as the "Emergency Farm Mortgage Act of 1933", hereinafter called "Commissioner", party of the second part,

WITNESSETH: THAT WHEREAS, said Mortgagor is justly indebted to said Commissioner in the principal sum of \$3400.00, this day lent said Mortgagor by said Commissioner;

AND WHEREAS, said Mortgagor has executed and delivered to said Commissioner his promissory note, dated JANUARY 2nd, 1934 for said principal sum of \$3400.00, with interest on said principal sum, or unpaid balance thereof, at the rate of five per centum per annum, payable semi-annually on the FIRST day of JULY and JANUARY in each year, said principal sum being payable on an amortization plan and in NINETEEN equal successive semi-annual instalments of \$170.00 each, the first such instalment being payable on the FIRST day of JULY, 1937, and the remaining instalments being payable on each succeeding interest payment date and a final instalment of \$170.00 payable on the FIRST day of JANUARY, 1947, unless the debt be sooner paid or matured; and the better to secure the payment of said principal sum and interest in the manner and at the time above set out, this mortgage is executed and delivered;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of \$1.00, said Mortgagor hereby grants and conveys unto said Commissioner, his successors and assigns,

ALL that piece or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in Liganore District, Frederick County, State of Maryland:

BEGINNING at a stone planted near a small hickory tree, said stone being the beginning of the ninth line of "Pearre's Retreat" and running with and bounding on said line allowing $2\frac{1}{2}$ D for East--variation South 72D - West 26P to a stone now planted - then by a line of Division South 33 $\frac{3}{4}$ D - West 28P - South $19\frac{1}{4}$ D - West $51\frac{1}{2}$ P - to a stone - South 69D, 22 minutes E. 126 $\frac{2}{10}$ P - to a stone - thence with lot No. 2 - allowing as before North $\frac{1}{2}$ D East - 132 $\frac{7}{10}$ P to a stone - and intersecting the 36th line of addition to "Pearre's Retreat" at the end of $85\frac{1}{2}$ P - then with said line allowing as before South - $87\frac{1}{2}$ D West - 26P to a stone South - $85\frac{1}{2}$ D West - $15\frac{1}{4}$ P to a stone South $73\frac{1}{2}$ D West - 23 $\frac{3}{4}$ P to place of beginning.

CONTAINING seventy (70) acres of land, more or less.

BEING the same land which was conveyed to said Isaac C. Gillespie and Mary V. Gillespie, his wife, by deed from William E. Williams and his wife, dated April 4, 1927, and recorded among the Land Records of said County in Land Book 362, page 237.
