Maryland, Witnesseth: That for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred and fifty
dollars, we the said Oliver H. Fogle and Clara B. Fogle, his wife, do grant and convey unto
Marcella Lewis in fee simple, all our right title and interest in and to the following real
estate, all that lot or parcel of ground with the improvements thereon, situate, lying and
being in Frederick County, Maryland, near Cedar Grove School House, along the Public Road
leading from Libertytown to Woodsboro, and containing two and one half acres and ten square
perches of land, and being the same lot or parcel of land that was conveyed to the said
Oliver H. Fogle, by a deed dated on the first day of August in the year Nineteen hundred and
four, from John D. Smith, and recorded in Liber S. T. H. No. 267, folio 229, one of the land
records of Frederick County, a reference thereto being had a full description as to metes
and bounds will appear, and also, being a part of the same land that John D. Smith obtained
