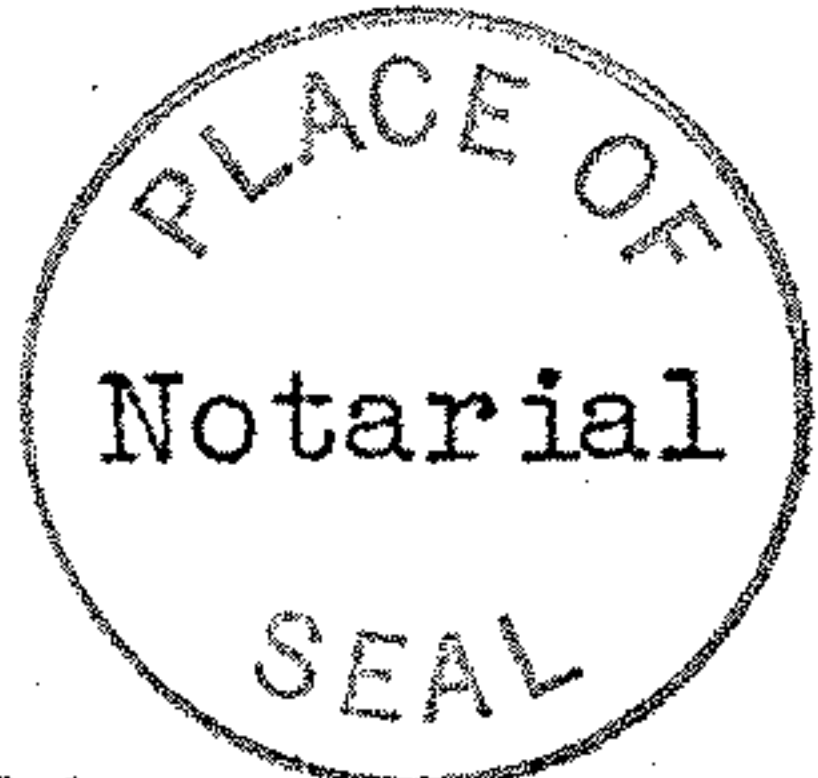
And your Petitioner reports the aggregate amount of said sale to be \$200.00 and prays that said sale may be finally ratified and confirmed.
