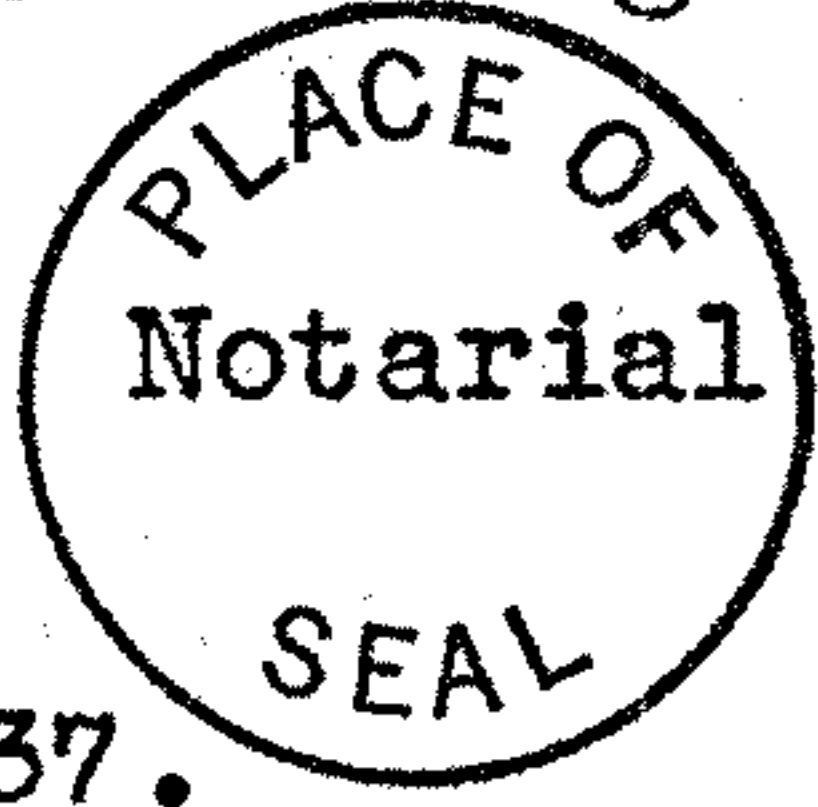
The Answer of Rachel Hammond to the Bill of Complaint filed against her in this cause says:
