TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The bill of complaint of Leonard K. Grossnickle, Elsie Grossnickle, Lloyd A. Grossnickle, and Bertha Grossnickle, respectfully represents:

1. That a certain Albert E. Grossnickle, late of Frederick County, Maryland, deceased, departed this life, intestate, on or about the day of June, 1936, and left surviving him, as his only heirs at law, no widow, child, descendant, father nor mother, but the following brothers and sister, and the descendants of a deceased brother, to-wit:

a. William E. Grossnickle, a brother whose wife's name is Cora Grossnickle, both residents of Waynesboro, in the State of Pennsylvania.

b. Leonard K. Grossnickle, a brother whose wife's name is Elsie Grossnickle, both residents of Frederick County, Maryland.

c. Carrie Burnett, a sister, whose husband's name is Ira A. Burnett, both residents of Chicago in the State of Illinois.

d. Lloyd A. Grossnickle, a brother, whose wife's name is Bertha Grossnickle, both residents of Frederick County, Maryland.

e. The following children of George O. Grossnickle, a deceased brother, to-wit:

(a) George P. Grossnickle, a son, whose wife's name is Doris Grossnickle, both residents of Brooklyn, New York.

(b) Helen Fischer, a daughter whose husband's name is Fred Fischer, both residents of 200 Slade Ave., Pikesville, Maryland.

(c) Robert Grossnickle, a son, whose wife's name is Anna Grossnickle, both residents of 2545 Robb St., Baltimore, Maryland.

(d) Mehrl Grossnickle, an infant son, residing at No. 200 Slade Avenue, Pikesville, Maryland, and

(e) Carolyn Grossnickle, an infant daughter, residing at No. 200 Slade Ave., Pikesville, Maryland.

2. That said Albert E. Grossnickle, was, at the time of his death, seized and possessed of the following described real estate located in Hauvers District, in said Frederick County, Maryland, to-wit:

(a) All that farm located near Deerfield Station in Frederick County, Maryland, containing 102 acres of land, more or less, and being the same real estate which was conveyed to the said Albert E. Grossnickle from John H. Ambrose and others by deed dated April 3, 1926, and recorded in Liber No. 402 at folio 430, one of the land records for Frederick County, a certified copy of which deed is filed herewith and marked Exhibit "A".
