TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The petition of Morris G. Black, Administrator and creditor of the Estate of W. Geyer Black, deceased, late of Frederick County, Maryland, respectfully shows unto your Honors:

1. That on the 18th day of October, 1937, your Petitioner filed in your Honorable Court a Bill of Complaint against the several Defendants therein named, praying that the proceedings in the above numbered Equity cause may be converted into a Creditor's Bill, as the same affects the interests of the late W. Geyer Black in and to the real estate, or the proceeds thereof, of the late Maggie E. Black, heretofore sold under Partition Proceedings in the said Equity case.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner prays that your Honorable Court will pass an order appointing a guardian ad litem to appear and answer for the said infant Defendants.

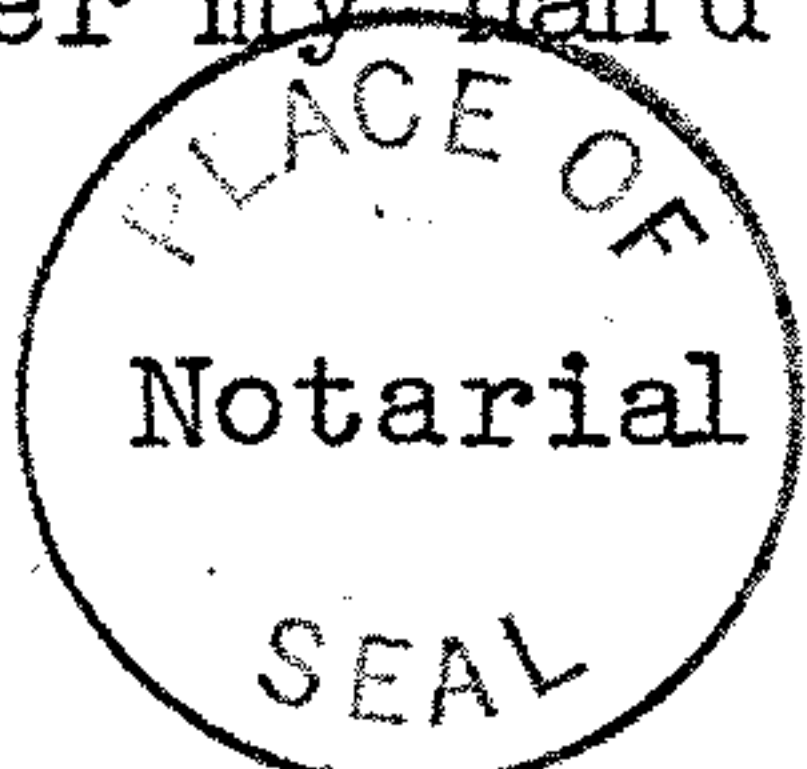
