

Lots hereinafter to be devised and in which devise the rights of way shall be specifically recited: (3) Also all that Mountain land designated as Lots No 2, 3, and 4, in the deed from Aery McDevitt et al, to Peter H. Bussard, dated March 4th, 1871 and recorded in Liber C. M. No. 6, Folio 539, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, containing  $103\frac{1}{2}$  ACRES of land more or less.

Fifth:

I give and devise unto my son, John W. Bussard, the following described Mountain Land, situated in Frederick County, Maryland, Viz: (1) Lot No. 41, containing  $31\frac{1}{8}$  ACRES more or less: Lot No. 42 containing  $23\frac{3}{4}$  ACRES of land more or less: Lot No. 43, containing  $30\frac{1}{16}$  ACRES of land more or less; Lot No. 44, containing  $13\frac{1}{8}$  ACRES of land more or less, which are described and set forth in the deed from Catoctin Iron Company to Peter H. Bussard, dated October 10th, 1885, and recorded in Liber A. F. No. 11, Folio 384 etc, one of the said Land Records, being Lots Nos. 41, 42, 43, 44, on the Plat of ground offered for sale by the said Catoctin Iron Company on September 30th, 1885. (2) I also give and devise unto my son, John W. Bussard, that piece of Mountain Land containing 26 ACRES, 2 ROODS and 5 SQUARE PERCHES of land more or less, which was conveyed to me by deed from Abraham A. Albaugh and wife, dated March 18th, 1868, and recorded in Liber C. M. No. 6, Folio 535 etc, one of said Land Records; also all that piece or parcel of land containing 4 ACRES, 1 ROOD and 18 PERCHES of land more or less, which was conveyed to me by deed executed by Clayton O. Keedy Trustee, dated April 15th, 1889, and recorded in Liber W. I. P. No. 9, folio 206 etc, one of said Land Records; also a strip of land containing 2 ROODS and 22 SQUARE PERCHES of land, said strip of land to be of uniform width and to extend along the Northern boundry line of Lot No. 5 containing 15 ACRES, 2 ROODS and 26 SQUARE PERCHES of land more or less which was conveyed unto the said Peter H. Bussard by deed executed by Baker J. Lamar, Acting Executor, dated April 1st, 1874, and recorded in Liber T. G. No. 1, Folio 355, etc, one of the said Land Records, being a part of said Lot No. 5, and extending along the Northern boundry line of said Lot, and of sufficient uniform width to contain 2 ROODS and 22 SQUARE PERCHES of land; and I further give and devise unto my said son, John W. Bussard, the right of way over and to the private road reserved in the devise of Mountain Land to my son Charles L. Bussard in the fourth paragraph of this will, for the use and benefit of the several lots of land devised unto my said son John W. Bussard in this fifth paragraph of this will which are acesible to said private roads; I also give and devise unto my son, John W. Bussard those two lots of land containing  $29\frac{1}{8}$  ACRES and  $20\frac{7}{8}$  ACRES of land respectively, which were conveyed unto the said Peter H. Bussard by deed executed by the Catoctin Iron Company dated October 17th 1885, and recorded in Liber A. F. No. 11 Folio 385 etc, one of the said Land Records, the same being Lots No 32 and 33 on the Plat of Land as offered for sale by the said Catoctin Iron Company on September 30th, 1885.

Sixth:

I give and devise unto my son, Peter E. Bussard, the following described Mountain Land, situated in Frederick County, Maryland, Viz: (1) Lot No. 38, containing  $24\frac{1}{2}$  ACRES of land more or less: Lot No. 39 containing  $32\frac{1}{2}$  ACRES of land more or less; Lot No 40, containing  $28\frac{1}{2}$  ACRES of land more or less, which are described and set forth in the said deed from the Catoctin Iron Company to Peter H. Bussard, dated October 10th, 1885, and recorded in Liber A. F. No. 11, Folio 384 etc, one of the said Land Records being Lots Nos. 38, 39 and 40 on the Plat of ground offered for sale by the Catoctin Iron Company, September 30th 1885; (2) I also gove and devise unto my said son, Peter E. Bussard all that part or portion of the land conveyed to me by deed executed by Samuel P. Bussard and wife, dated March 15th, 1892, and recorded in Liber J. L. J. No. 1, Folio 206 etc, one of said Land Records, the said part or portion which I hereby give and devise unto my said
