WHEREFORE, your Petitioner prays that your Honors will ratify the sale as made and reported by your Petitioner unto your Honorable Court.

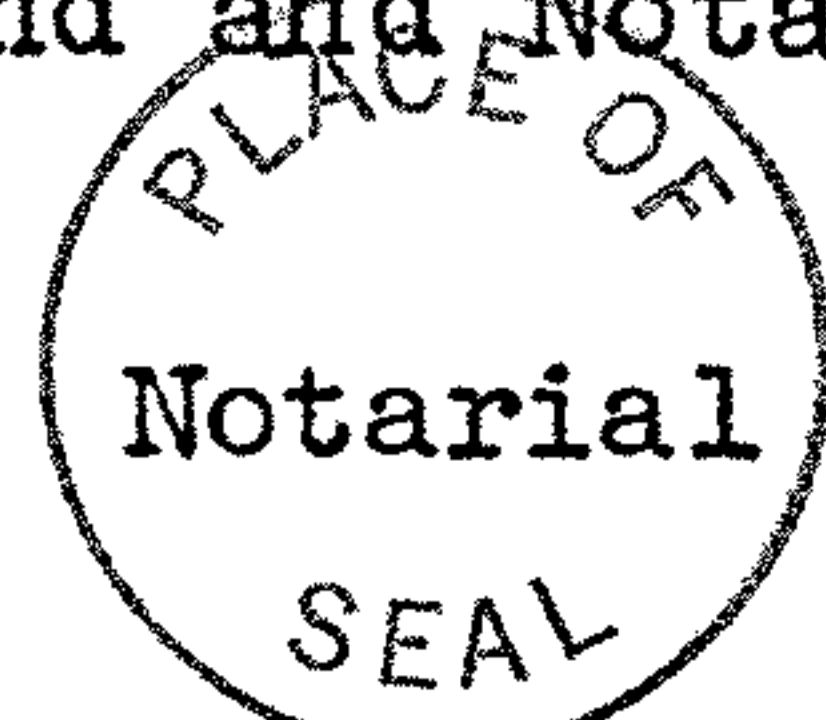
