

of all, or such part as may be necessary, of the real estate of their aforesaid debtor.

7. That the aforesaid dwelling needs considerable repairing and painting; that a great deal of trouble is involved in the matter of renting and the looking after said premises and that it would be to the best interests of all of the infants aforesaid that the said land and premises be sold under the supervision of this Court and the proceeds therefrom used for the payment of all of the just and proper debts of the said Lucy V. Gosnell, deceased, and the remainder distributed among the said infants according to law.

TO THE END, THEREFORE,

That a decree may be passed for the sale of the said real estate, and for the appointment of a trustee or trustees to effect the same.

2. That the proceeds of said sale may be distributed according to the rights of the parties herein or who may be made parties herein.

3. That your petitioners may have such other and further relief as the nature of this cause may require.

May it please your Honors to grant unto your petitioners the writ of subpoena, directed to the said Charles H. Gosnell, George M. Gosnell, Bernard T. Gosnell and Helen D. Gosnell, infants, c/o Nettie M. Haller, Frederick, Maryland, The Domestic Building Association of Frederick County, a body corporate, Frederick, Maryland, and Nettie M. Haller, Administratrix of the goods and chattels of Lucy V. Gosnell, deceased, Frederick, Maryland, commanding them, and each of them, to be and appear, either in person or by solicitor, in this Court, on or before a certain day to be named therein, to show cause, if any they have, why a decree ought not to be passed as prayed.

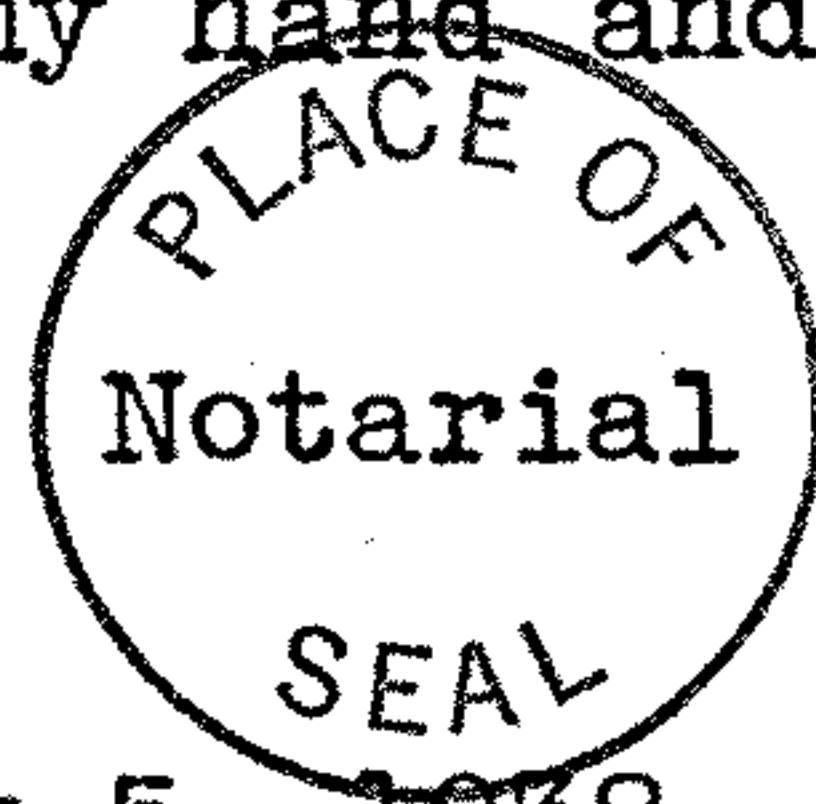
