

The Petition of T. Clyde Routson, respectfully shows unto your Honors:

FIRST: That your Petitioner brings this proceeding for himself as well as for all other creditors of Emma S. Anderson, deceased, who will come in and contribute to the expenses of this suit.

SECOND: That the said Emma S. Anderson was, in her lifetime indebted unto your Petitioner T. Clyde Routson, in the full and just sum of Fifty dollars for medical attention to her rendered during her last illness, a statement of which is filed herewith. and marked "Exhibit Claim No. I."

2nd. And for such other and further relief as the nature of this case may require.
