To the Honorable Judges of said Court:

Your Petitioner, Jess S. Dailey who sues for himself as a creditor of Alverda Barnard in his own behalf and in behalf of all other creditors who will come in and contribute to the expense of this suit respectfully represents unto your Honorable Court:

FIRST. That the said Alverda Barnard died intestate on or about March 17, 1937 leaving certain real estate situate in Frederick County, Maryland, located in the Town of Brunswick, described in a deed from Benjamin D. Duvall and Laura M. Duvall, his wife to William E. Barnard and Alverda Barnard, his wife, dated March 19, 1901 and recorded in Liber D. H. H. No. 11 folio 279 one of the land records of Frederick County, Maryland, that the said William E.
