To the Honorable, the Judges of said Court:

The BILL OF COMPLAINT of Jeremiah P. Karn, trading as J. P. Karn and Bro. on behalf of himself as well as all other creditors of Willoughby N. Lemen who may come in and contribute to the costs and expenses of this proceeding, respectfully shows unto your Honors:

1st. That the said Willoughby N. Lemen was in his lifetime and at the time of his death seized and possessed of a certain piece of land known as a lot in the town of Brunswick, Frederick County, Maryland, which was conveyed to him by deed executed by R. J. Stup and M. E. Stup his wife, bearing date October 6th. A. D. 1891, and duly recorded among the Land Records of Frederick County aforesaid, as will appear by reference to a certified copy of said deed filed herewith marked "Exhibit A", which, together with any and all other exhibits herewith filed, it is prayed may be taken and considered as a part of this Bill.

2nd. That the said Willoughby N. Lemen was indebted unto your Complainant at the time of his death, in the sum of Twenty-Two dollars and Two cents (\$22.02), as will appear by reference to a memorandum of said account filed herewith and marked "Exhibit B".

3rd. That the said Willoughby N. Lemen, being indebted as aforesaid, departed this life on July 25th. A. D. 1913, at said Frederick County, intestate, leaving no last will leaving surviving him a widow, Marie B. Lemen and a daughter Tabitha C. Lemen an infant about ten years of age, both the above named defendants to this cause, and both residing
