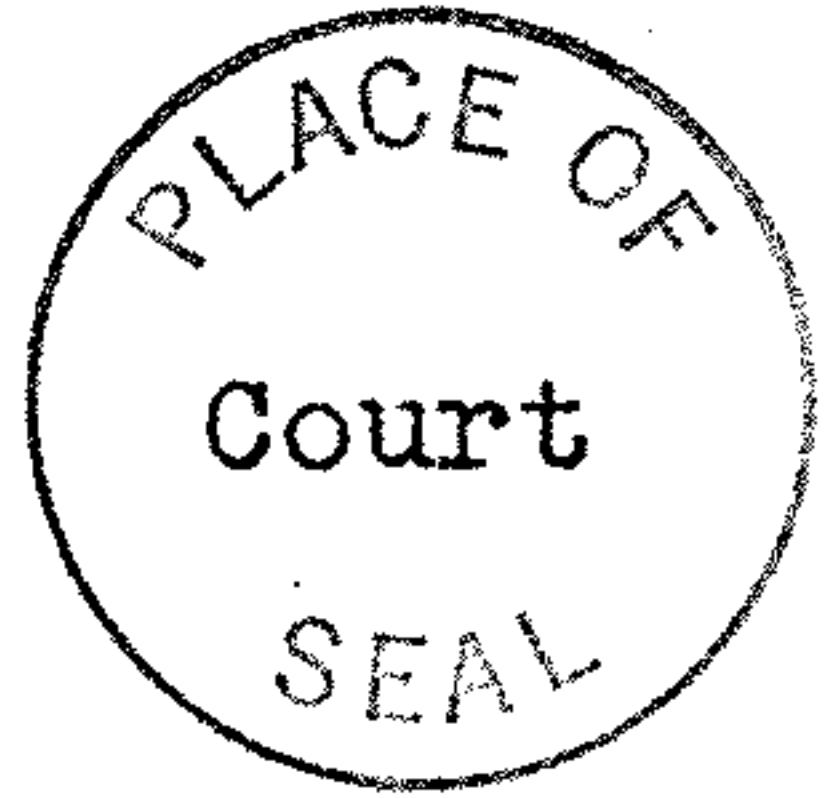
STATE OF MARYLAND, FREDERICK COUNTY, TO-WIT:
