2nd. That your petitioner is informed that no administration has been taken out upon the estate of Mary E. Cromwell, who died in the year 1938, intestate and a resident of Montgomery County, Maryland, and who at the time of her death was the owner of an undivided one ninth interest in said real estate.

3rd. That your petitioner is advised that no administration has been taken out upon the estate of C. Cromwell Kessler, who died intestate in the year 1937, who at the time of his death was a resident of Frederick County, Maryland, and who died seized and possessed of an undivided one thirteenth interest in an undivided one ninth interest in said real estate.

4th. That Ernest W. Kessler, who died on the 9th day of February 1938, intestate, and who at the time of his death was a non-resident of the State of Maryland and resided in the City of Washington, in the District of Columbia, was seized and possessed of an undivided one thirteenth interest in an undivided one ninth interest in said real estate.
