The petition of Amos A. Holter, Assignee of the Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation, a body corporate, Assignee of the Land Bank Commissioner, Mortgagee of John M. Lease and Josephine R. Burrall Lease, his wife, respectfully shows unto your Honors:

1. That the said John M. Lease and Josephine R. Burrall Lease, his wife, being indebted unto the Land Bank Commissioner, acting pursuant to Part 3 of the Act of Congress of the United States of America known as the "Emergency Farm Mortgage Act of 1933," in the sum of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00), executed their promissory note for the said sum of money on the 1st day of December, 1933, the said sum of money being payable with interest thereon on the unpaid balance thereof at the rate of five per cent (5%) per annum, payable semi-annually on the 1st day of June and December in each year, the said principal sum being payable on an amortization plan and in twenty equal successive semi-annual installments of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) each in accordance with the amortization plan provided by the said Land Bank Commissioner, which will more fully appear by reference to the mortgage note filed herewith marked Exhibit "A" and which is prayed may be taken and considered a part hereof, and for the purpose of better securing the payment of said promissory note, the said John M.
