Bell, Silas Rickards and Vernon Boone, Trustees of Bethel Tabernacle their successors and assigns certain property on the north side of Ninth Street in Frederick City and County, Maryland which deed is recorded in Liber 376 folio 559 one of the Land Records for Frederick County,
