Norris his wife of Frederick County and State of Maryland -- Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty three dollars & fifty six cents - the said Nicholas E. Norris and Fannie W. Norris his wife do grant unto Wm. H. Hill of aforesaid County and State, the following described piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in Frederick County Maryland being a part of that piece of land conveyed to Nicholas E. Norris by deed from the heirs of Nicholas Norris late of Frederick County deceased dated the 21st day of June 1882 and recorded in Liber A. F.
