This Deed, made this 6th day of October in the year Eighteen hundred and Eighty six by Nicholas E. Norris and Fannie W. Norris his wife, of Frederick County, and State of Maryland, Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifteen Dollars the said Nicholas E. Norris and Fannie W. Norris, his wife, do grant unto Mary Elizabeth Hill, of aforesaid County and State the following described piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in Frederick County, Maryland being a part of that piece of land conveyed to Nicholas E. Norris by deed from the heirs of Nicholas Norris late of Frederick County deceased dated the 21st day of June 1882 and recorded in Liber A. F. No. 5, folio 395, 396 &c., one of the Land Records of Frederick County.

Beginning for the outlines of said piece or parcel of land at the end of twenty nine and three tenth ps. on the eleventh line of the whole tract and running with said line corrected South seventy five and a half degrees West six and three twentieth ps. thence South twenty two and a half degrees West twenty six and seven tenth ps. thence North forty two degrees East Six and three quarter ps. thence North twenty two degrees West twenty two and one fifth ps. to the place of beginning.
