TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The petition of Leslie N. Coblentz, Administrator of the estate of Martha Biehl, respectfully shows unto your Honors:

1. That on the 4th day of August, 1943, your Petitioner filed in your Honorable Court a Bill of Complaint against Catherine Crumbacker, Frances Crumbacker and Nancy Crumbacker, infants, et. al., praying that your Honorable Court might pass a decree ordering the sale of the real estate of the said Martha Biehl for the purpose of paying the debts of said decedent, and that the proceeds of said sale may be distributed to the creditors of the said decedent.

2. That subpoenas were duly issued and notices duly served upon the said Defendants commanding them to be and appear in your Honorable Court on the first Monday of September, 1943, to answer said petition or to file any other defense which the said Defendants may have to the proceedings herein within fifteen days after the aforementioned return day, but that the said Catherine Crumbacker, Frances Crumbacker and Nancy Crumbacker are infants and, therefore, cannot answer the aforesaid suit for themselves.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner prays that your Honorable Court will pass an order appointing a guardian ad litem to appear and answer for the said infant Defendants in the proceedings heretofore filed in this cause.
