TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

Notice having been given me by the Plaintiff of the desire to take testimony in said cause, I, C. Clifton Virts, one of the Standing Examiners of your Honorable Court, duly appointed, qualified and sworn, having assigned the 13th day of November, 1943, at 10:30 o'clock A. M., at the office of Leslie N. Coblentz, Frederick, Maryland, as the time and place for taking the testimony in said cause, did, at the appointed time and place, proceed to take the following depositions, to-wit:

Annie I. Webster, witness

Annie I. Webster, a witness of lawful age, produced on behalf of the Plaintiff, duly deposes and says:

Q. State your name, age and address, please.

A. Annie I. Webster; 1931 East North Avenue, Baltimore, Maryland, 73 years of age.

Q. What is your occupation, Mrs. Webster?

A. Companion to a retired dentist.

Q. What relation were you to Martha Biehl?

A. Her sister.

Q. What was your father's name?

A. My father was Jesse Crumbacker, and he lived in Carroll County.

Q. Do you have any other brothers or sisters living?

A. Yes, I have two brothers living, and their names are Elmer Ira Crumbacker, who lives in Philadelphia, Pa., and Edgar B. Crumbacker, who lives at Union Bridge, Md. I have one sister, Mrs. Nettie Hubley, who lives in Baltimore, Md.

Q. How many brothers do you have who are dead?

A. William is dead; he died December 28, 1922.

Q. Did he leave any children?

A. Yes. William C. Crumbacker, whose wife's name is Irma, who lives in Baltimore, Md.; Howard Crumbacker, whose wife's name is Fannie Crumbacker, who lives in Baltimore, Md., children by his first wife. Then these children by a second wife: Jesse LeRoy Crumbacker, whose wife's name is Ruth Crumbacker, who lives in Baltimore, Md.; Norman Crumbacker, whose address is unknown, who is in the United States Army; David Crumbacker, whose wife's name is Annie Crumbacker, who lives at Chester, Pa.; Harry Crumbacker, whose wife's name is Dorothy Crumbacker, who reside in Baltimore, Md.; Cecelia Gluth, whose husband's name is Edward A. Gluth, who lives in Washington, D. C.; Myrtle Schultheis, whose husband's name is Walter F. Schultheis, who lives in Baltimore, Md.; Lola Hartman, whose husband's name is William Hartman, who lives in Baltimore.

My brother, George Crumbacker, died on January 10, 1941, and his children are: Charles Crumbacker, whose wife's name is Emma Crumbacker, who lives in Carroll County, Md.; Merle Crumbacker, whose wife's name is Mary Crumbacker, who also lives in Carroll County, Md.; Harold Crumbacker, who died on March 28, 1930, and left two children: Catherine Crumbacker and Frances Crumbacker - the one is about 16 years old and I think the other is about 14.
