TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Petition of Mrs. Bessie K. Stauffer, trading as Pearl Bargain House, through her Solicitor, Edward D. Storm, respectfully shows unto your Honors:

FIRST: That Leonard Sier, et al, Petitioned your Honorable Court on January 19th, 1942 to Order the sale of certain real estate in Frederick County, State of Maryland.

SECOND: That pursuant to the Decree of your Honorable Court passed on February 10th, 1943, H. Kieffer DeLauter and George R. Dennis, Jr., Trustees, proceeded to sell said real estate at and for the sum of seven hundred and five (\$705.00) dollars, as has been reported to your Honorable Court in the Petition and Report filed by the said Trustees on March 15th, 1943.

THIRD: That Maynard Siers, one of the heirs entitled to share in the proceeds of said sale, is indebted to your Petitioner in the sum of forty-one dollars and eleven cents (\$41.11) with interest from August 14, 1940 and with costs amounting to two dollars and ten cents (\$2.10), as is evidenced by the Judgment filed and recorded as No. 786 in the record of Magistrate Judgments No. 9, it being one of the Record Books in the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland; a certified copy of said Judgment being filed herewith as "PETITIONER'S EXHIBIT NO. 1".

FOURTH: That Mrs. Claude Siers, one of the heirs entitled to share in the proceeds of said sale, is indebted to your Petitioner in the sum of six (\$6.00) dollars, as is evidenced by the itemized account filed herewith as "PETITIONER'S EXHIBIT NO. 2".

FIFTH: That Walter Sier, one of the heirs entitled to share in the proceeds of said sale, is indebted unto your Petitioner in the sum of Seventeen dollars and twenty-eight cents (\$17.28), as is evidenced by the itemized account filed herewith as "PETITIONER'S EXHIBIT NO. 3".

SIXTH: That your Petitioner desires to have the shares of the said Maynard Siers, Mrs. Claude Siers, and Walter Sier, in and to the proceeds of said sale applied toward the discharge of the claims of your said Petitioner.

TO THE END, THEREFORE,

1st. That your Honorable Court may direct the Trustees in these proceedings to apply the share of the said Maynard Sier, in and to the money in their hands, toward the discharge of the claim of your Petitioner, against the said Maynard Sier.

2nd. That your Honorable Court may direct the said Trustees in these proceedings to apply the share of the said Mrs. Claude Siers, in and to the money in their hands, toward the discharge of the claim of your Petitioner, against the said Mrs. Claude Siers.

3rd. That your Honorable Court may direct the Trustees in these proceedings to apply the share of the said Walter Sier, in and to the money in their hands, toward the discharge of the claim of your Petitioner against the said Leonard Sier.
