The Bill of Complaint filed in this cause alleges that Charles F. Rothenhoefer, departed this life on or about the twenty-first day of December, in the year Nineteen Hundred and Forty-two, seized and possessed of the following lots and parcels of land situate, lying and being in Frederick City, Frederick County, State of Maryland, and more particularly described as follows:

1. All that tract or parcel of land fronting thirty-two (32) feet on the north side of East Seventh Street and running back two hundred thirty (230) feet, and being the same property conveyed to Charles F. Rothenhoefer by deed from William Bopst and wife, bearing date on the nineteenth day of November, in the year Eighteen Hundred and Ninety two, and recorded in Liber J.L.J. No. 3, Folio 284, one of the Land Records of Frederick County.

2. All that parcel of land located on the north side of East Seventh Street, being sixty (60) feet by two hundred (200) feet, and being the same parcel of land conveyed to Charles F. Rothenhoefer by deed from William Bopst and wife, bearing date on the twenty-ninth day of March, Eighteen Hundred and Ninety-nine, and recorded in Liber D.H.H. No. 17, Folio 414, one of the Land Records of Frederick County.

3. All that parcel of land located on the north side of East Seventh Street and fronting thereon sixty (60) feet and running back two hundred (200) feet, being the same property conveyed to Charles F. Rothenhoefer, by deed from William Bopst and wife, bearing date on the first day of May, in the year Nineteen Hundred and Seven, and recorded in Liber No. 284, Folio 323, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, less that parcel of land thirty (30) feet by two hundred (200) feet, conveyed to Lewis W. M.
